Full training and support is provided. Duties and responsibilities include:

- Setting up large screen for movie afternoons
- Writing postcards
- Going for walks with guests around the grounds
- Assisting guests to use computers
- Games, quizzes etc
- Other activities as requested by individual guests
- Assisting guests with teas and coffees
- Assisting with the Leuchie shop
